Dear parent or carer,

Final Day

Friday 11 May marks the final day of school before the commencement of GCSE examination leave and to celebrate this, the day will run differently to a normal school day.

Registration/Assembly, Period 1 and Period 2 – These are as normal.

At the end of period 2, students will attend an examination briefing in the sports hall before changing to participate in a series of activities to reward their hard work this year.

The activity will comprise of several events and a barbeque lunch. The events will be tug-o-war, egg and spoon, three legged relay and an inflatable obstacle course. Students should bring some warm clothing and a towel in case of rain, but may also require sun cream if the weather is hot.

Please note that phones/cameras should not be used on this day. If students wish to get shirts signed, they should bring in a spare shirt to sign (not the one being worn) and ensure that any comments are appropriate. The event will end between 14.00 and 14.30 at which point the students will be dismissed from school. Please notify school if you do not consent to your son/daughter taking part in these activities.

Exam Period

Once exams begin, please ensure that arrival for all exams is prompt. If your child is too ill to sit an exam, please inform the school as soon as possible and be aware that medical evidence will be required to submit to the exam board. During the exam period, there will be a series of exam booster sessions held in school and your child has had the opportunity to sign up for these sessions. At other times there will be some study rooms available should students wish to revise independently in school. Students should wear school uniform for all activities in school, including exam booster sessions.

Please note, book return day will take place on Wednesday 20 June; students should meet in the Swann Hall at 09.30. If any books have been lost, then a replacement fee must be paid. A list of books and costs will be provided on the day. Once all books/monies are returned, if students have ordered a yearbook, it can be collected from Mrs Hanson. Following this, students will attend a lunch and induction activities in the sixth form and due to this, they are not required to wear school uniform on this day.
