Collecting Results

Results will be available from school between 8.30am and 10.30am. Students should enter the school through the main reception and make their way to the Sports Hall to collect their results. To help to manage numbers in the building and allow for appropriate social distancing, we ask that students come into the building alone. We may require students to wear masks while moving around the building, and will confirm this in our communication on 9 August.

Any results that have not been collected will be emailed to students at 11am. There will be a link to a destination form included in the email, which we ask that you complete as soon as possible.

After Collecting Results

In your results envelope you will find a destination form. Please complete this and hand it in before you leave. We will also ask for contact details so that we can contact you with details of future events such as Prize-giving.

Once you have collected your results you are free to leave the site. If you need any support with your University application, the Sixth Form Team and the Careers Team will be available in the ILA to help. You can also arrange to come into school on Wednesday 10 August for further support with the clearing process. If you need to do this, you will need to email Mr Oxy with details of what you want to discuss. He will then give you an appointment time with the best person to help you.
