The Under 13 cricket team finally got to play their twice postponed 2nd round match in the Joe Root U13 challenge cup. Opponents Whitcliffe Mount won the toss and opted to bat.

The overcast weather conditions were always going to aid the bowlers and Heckmondwike's bowling attack exploited them fully. Captain Abdul Bhatti made a great start getting the ball to swing and limited scoring opportunities for the Whitcliffe opening batters. He was well supported by Shivank Tiwari who took the key wicket of Whitcliffe's Captain, with his

second unplayable delivery taking out middle stump. Abdul went on to take two wickets for 7 runs from 3 overs. The rest of the wickets were evenly spread amongst the bowlers with Vamsi Vakamallu, Devansh Desai, Lavitr Mehn and Siddhartha Mondal all taking one each.

Due to Heckmondwike's excellent bowling and fielding, Whitcliffe were limited to 63 runs from their 12 overs.

Openers Sahil Mukadam and Saffiullah Abrar knew that although they were chasing a modest total, the conditions were not going to aid their cause. Sahil made a great start with excellent shot selection and running between the wickets to keep the scorer busy. He finished on 18 runs after being controversially given out - caught behind. Abdul joined Safiullah at the crease and they made light work of reaching the target of 64 runs with three overs remaining. Safiullah finished on 15 and Abdul 17 both not out.




There was also an excellent wicket keeping display by Oliver Blakeley.


