A [two day residential for Year 12 science students](#). It will take place on Monday 18 July to Tuesday 19 July 2022.

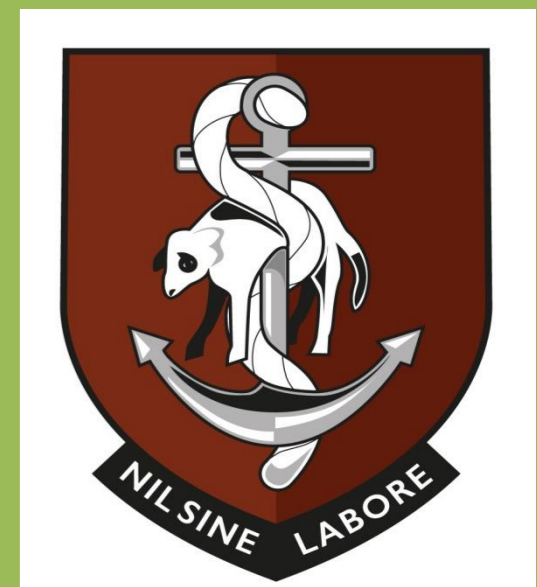
The Food Science & Nutrition Summer School aims to give young scientists an introduction to this multidisciplinary science subject and find out more about studying the subject at the University of Leeds
