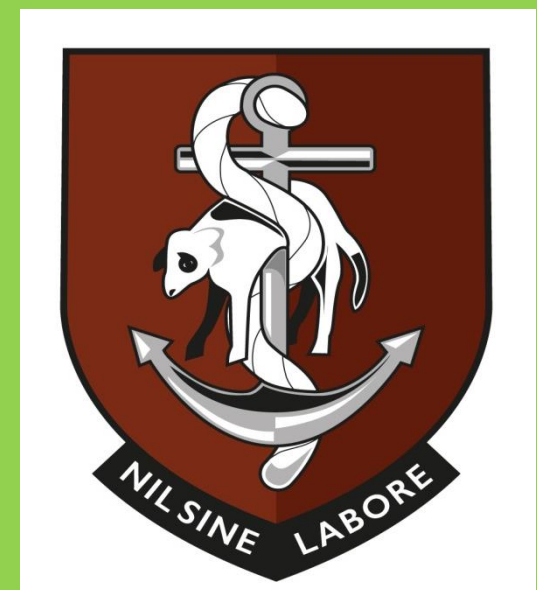

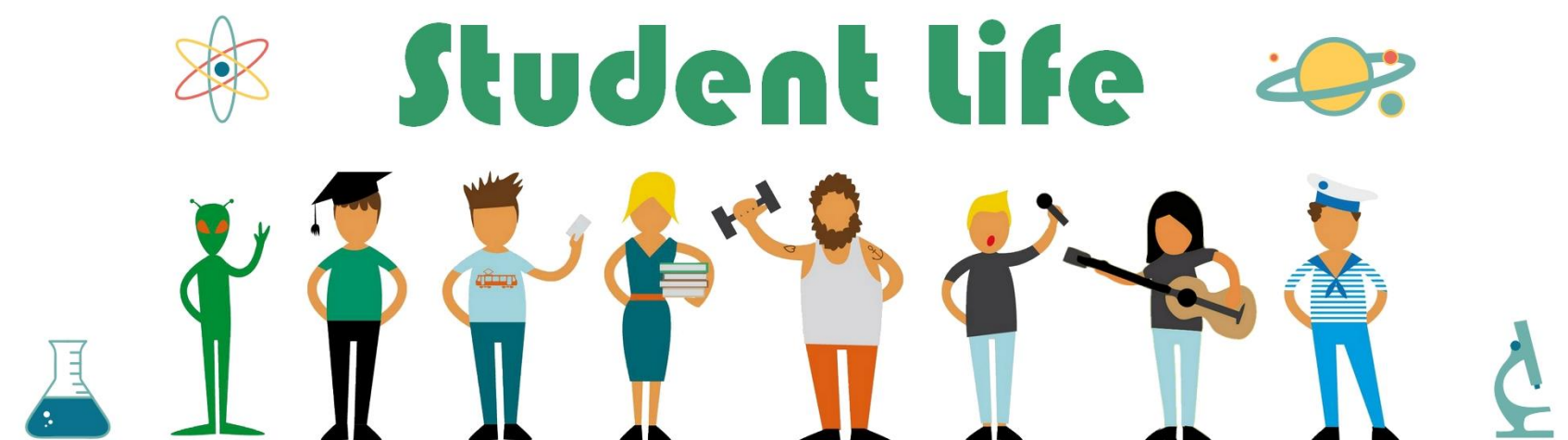

- Tread water for 30 seconds
- Surface dive to deepest part of the pool to retrieve a casualty manikin
- Climb out of the pool unaided
- 50m timed swim (No longer than 60 seconds)

Biological Sciences Summer School

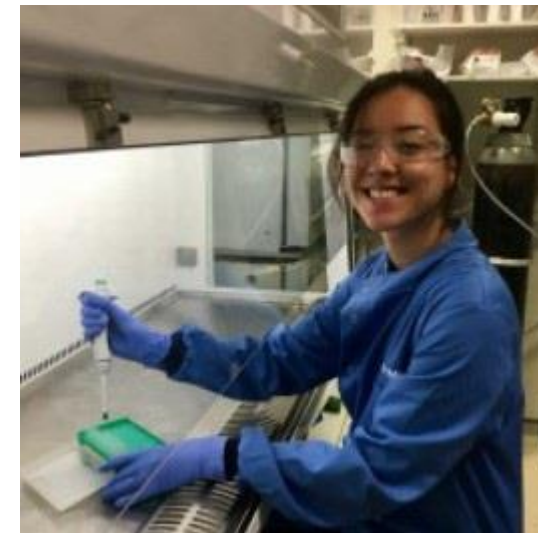
