Dear parent/carer,

Firstly, we would like to commend Year 12 on their approach to their recent final exams. They worked hard on revision and were well prepared for these important assessments. Their behaviour was excellent and they were respectful of other students sitting exams. They will be getting feedback on these exams over the next few days and weeks and their exam grades will be reported home the week commencing Monday 23 May 2022.

This week, as students return from their study leave, we would like to outline a key change to their daily routine. As part of the push towards the very best outcomes for all students in our Sixth Form and also as students start their preparation for Year 13 following their finals, all students will need to be in registration with their form tutor every morning. They will need to be in their form room at 8.40 each morning from Monday 16 May. This will allow students to have bespoke discussions with their tutor about their exams, and have time to reflect on them. They will be guided to create and work towards meaningful targets following their feedback and results.

Moreover, it will allow for targeted and detailed work to be done around progression onto the next stage in their life, whether this is university, an apprenticeship or employment. Some applications need to go in to universities early at the start of the next academic year and, along with other events organised and run by our careers team, this additional time in registration will be utilised to support all students with this.
