PROGRESSION CONFERENCE

*Year 10
Year 12*

The progression conference is back in person this year and will take place in July.

Students in year 12 will attend workshops and the careers fair. Both will be an opportunity to meet a wide range of representatives from Universities, local employers and apprenticeship providers as well as HGS alumni.

Students in year 10 will also attend the fair. It is a chance for them to start thinking about their options for the future. This prepares them for the start of year 11, where they make their post 16 choices and have a conversation with one of the careers advisers.



MOCK INTERVIEWS *Year 10*

Year 10 will have an employer led Mock Interview session in July. We are again working with Ahead Partnership to make this happen.

The aim of the mock interviews is to increase students' awareness of employer expectations, increase their confidence and their motivation in school. The session will also help to build their optimism for the future as they receive feedback from the employers. Students will get the chance to present a job sector of their choice to the employer during their interview and also answer general interview questions.

Students will be prepared before their interviews by tutors and the careers team.

CAREERS GUIDANCE INTERVIEWS *Year 12*

We continue to invite Year 12 students for their one to one guidance interviews.

The interview is a chance for students to discuss their aspirations with an impartial and qualified careers adviser and discuss all their options.

Students are sent a summary of their guidance interview containing everything discussed and are encouraged to attend the careers drop in if they have any further questions
