Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you about the Mathematics course that your child will be studying in Key Stage 4. Your child will sit GCSE Mathematics at the end of year 11. We are following the exam board AQA Higher specification.

There are also some set changes taking place next year. In year 10, there will be 8 teaching groups. Mr Bensley's group will also study the Level 3 Additional Mathematics qualification, most of the content will be taught in Year 11. We anticipate that students in sets taught by Ms Jarvis, Mr Brooke-Mawson and Mr Mullaney will also study the Level 2 Further Mathematics in addition to their GCSE Mathematics.

Following the mock examinations in year 11, the decision will be made as to which students will sit both Mathematics and Further Mathematics or just Mathematics. This is to ensure the correct level of challenge meets the individual need of your child. These sets will be reviewed throughout the year after internal mathematics exams.

Your child will find out their mathematics teacher when they receive their timetable next week.
