### **Autumn Mock Examinations**

We are about to enter the first mock examination period for students in years 11 & 13. The examinations begin when we return after half-term on Monday 31 October and continue until to 9/10 November. We have recently sent home the exam timetable and whilst this is the perfect opportunity for students to experience a more formal setting for examinations you will notice that they are conducted over a much more condensed period than the exam series in the summer. Mock examinations will take place in morning and afternoon sessions and students need to be aware of the following information with regards to these sessions:

**Morning sessions:** All students in year 11 & year 13 should register with their form tutor. At 8.50am year 11 students should congregate in the SCR; year 13 students should meet in the old ILA next to the SCR. When the exam hall is ready to receive students, we will invite them in. Exam conditions begin at the entrance to the sports hall corridor. For those students who may be in a slightly different room for their examinations they can make their way straight to the correct room; there is no need to go to the SCR/ILA. Exams will begin at 9.00am.

**Afternoon sessions:** Exams will begin at 1.15pm, students must ensure that they have had their lunch and are in the SCR/ILA, as described above, at 1.05pm.

All students should ensure that they store their bags in the lockers and have paid attention to the list of equipment they are allowed to take into the exam. This information has been sent with their exam timetable. It is also vital that they are wearing their ID badge and lanyard.

Please be aware that some exams might finish after the usual end of school, especially for those students who may have extra time for examinations and therefore it is important that students and parents arrange alternative travel arrangements should they need to.

When not in exams all students in years 11 & 13 should attend their usual timetabled lessons as normal. In many circumstances students will be allowed to revise in these lessons, however, there may be opportunities for teachers to continue with the curriculum.
