Students going to university

The deadline for students finalising their university course choices is the 8th of June 2023 in most cases. Students need to look at their UCAS accounts regularly to check the progress of their application. Failure to choose a firm choice and an insurance choice will result in your child losing their place and having to apply through clearing on results day.
