Dear Parents/Carer

Huddersfield and Manchester University Wednesday 12 July

I would like to invite your child to come to visit a local university and a prestigious Russell Group university. Both offer a wide range of courses from the sciences, arts and humanities to name but a few. We want to provide your child with the knowledge to help them make the best decision about their future, visiting universities will help clarify whether this is the right route for them to take.

We have selected Huddersfield University because nearly 30% of our students apply each year.

We have selected Manchester due to it being a Russell Group university. Over 43% of students are accepted by Russell Group universities each year.

Although these may not be the exact destinations your child wishes to attend it will help inform their decision about the type of institution they wish to attend, if at all.

Please find below the itinerary for the day

Students who are arriving by coach

- 7.45 arrive at school to register (in North Street)
- 8.00 Leave North Street

Students who meet at Huddersfield University

8.45 Meet at Huddersfield University, Brontë Lecture Theatres (see location 3 on the map attached). There will be student ambassadors wearing orange t-shirts at the university reception to students find their way to the theatre, should it be necessary.

- 9.00 Introduction and quiz
- 10.30 Campus tour
- 11. 30 12.00 Lunch (students to provide own, there are no facilities available to purchase items)
- 12.15 Leave school by coach (Storthes Hall Bus Stop)
- 13.15 Welcome talk and introduction to the Manchester University
- 2.15 Campus tour
- 3.15pm Departure from Manchester
- 4.15 pm Arrive back at school (North Street)

May I take this opportunity to remind parents that students are expected to display the very highest standards of behaviour and courtesy.

Under the School Governors' Charging and Remissions Policy, we request a contribution of £24 towards the cost of this activity. We must mention that without sufficient funding the trip will be unable to take place. This which will be payable via ParentPay by 5 June 2023.
