A Level Biology Field Trip – Cranedale Activity Centre

The visit is on Sunday 2 July until Monday 3 July 2023. We will travel by hired coach to Cranedale leaving school at approximately 8am on the Sunday 2 July. We shall be setting off back from Cranedale at approximately 4pm and therefore expect to return to school at approximately 6pm on the Monday 3 July, dependent on traffic.
