#### **Mock Interviews**

Year 10 and 12 students took part in employer led mock interviews last week. The experience forms part of the work experience programme within school and helps students get an idea of what an interview is like with someone they do not know. It is a chance for students to be put on the spot and discuss their skills and achievements. We worked in partnership with Ahead, who organised for volunteers from a range of sectors to come into school over the course of two days, including from companies such as Progeny Group, Jacobs Engineering, KPMG and Yorkshire Water.

The feedback from the employers was incredible, with many commenting on how impressed they were with the range of activities and experiences they are engaging in outside of the classroom. Employers look for students to be able to evidence their transferable skills in interviews by giving specific examples, so this was wonderful to hear.

Students feedback was positive with many saying they felt that the experience has prepared them for future interviews.



### YEAR 10 WORK EXPERIENCE WEEK

Work experience was launched to help our students' develop a greater appreciation of employment and experience the world of work whilst at the same time providing them with an opportunity to build self-confidence and reflect on their own skills. We have designed the programme to give students a similar experience to the real world of work and it will complement careers activities year 10 students are already undertaking allowing them to make informed decisions about their future. The majority of the students have sourced their own work experience with assistance being given where needed.

Feedback from both employers and students has been overwhelmingly positive.

He has had the chance to gain an understanding of how a law firm works, analyse legal documentation and is also working on an independent research project around international law. His supervisor commented on his listening skills and punctuality.


They have been tasked with creating an advertisement board for one of the stores current offers and were about to start
