Trip to Paris-France- 17-20 May 2024

In French, Years 9 students cover a range of topics allowing them to provide and understand information relating to their family, their routine and hobbies and their living environment. In Year 12, students explore current society trends in France as well as French culture and heritage. Next May, the Modern Foreign Languages Department would like to give Year 9 and Year 12 students who are currently learning French the opportunity to practise their language skills in real life situations, as well as gain a better understanding of French culture by going on a short visit to the French capital, Paris, from the Friday 17 until the Monday 20 May 2024.

At this stage, we are trying to gain expressions of interest for such a trip, to ensure that we have enough potential participants to make the visit viable. The final cost will depend on the number of students involved, but should be in the region of £750. This amount will be payable in instalments, to allow you to spread the cost.

We will be travelling by executive coach and ferry.

Our provisional itinerary includes the following activities:

- A visit to the Tuilleries Gardens
- A opportunity to see the Eiffel Tower
- A boat trip on the river Seine
- A walk alongside the Champs-Elysées
- An opportunity to see the Arc De Triomphe
- A walk through the Montmartre area
- A climb up the Montparnasse tower
