GCSE Music Trip - Wednesday 24 April 2024

We have arranged for our GCSE Music students to have the opportunity to visit the Alhambra Theatre in Bradford to see the musical **Wicked**. As the song Defying Gravity from Wicked is a GCSE music set work, I would strongly advise students to see the show to set the piece in context.

The visit is on **Wednesday 24 April 2024**. For this evening performance, <u>we would ask students</u> to make their own arrangements to get to and from the Alhambra Theatre. We will meet outside by the war memorial at **18:30** with pick up at approximately **22:15pm**. The war memorial is just outside the theatre on a large paved area and there is a turning circle on Morley Street very close by.

Students should bring any routine medication which they usually carry, for example inhalers. May I take this opportunity to remind parents that students are expected to display the very highest standards of behaviour and courtesy.
