Sunday Times Parent Power Guide for 2024 Results

Many of you will have seen in the press over the weekend the results of the Sunday Times Parent Power Guide for 2024. Widely acknowledged as the most authoritative survey of the UK's top state and independent schools, the guide ranks the country's highest-achieving secondary schools. The ranking is primarily based on A level and GCSE outcomes for the summer exams in 2023, with additional strengths of attendance and the extra-curricular offer this year taken into account.

I am delighted to inform you we are again ranked as the 2nd highest performing school in the North of England, very narrowly missing out on the top spot to Ripon Grammar School, which is a boarding school. However, even more pleasing, we have "soared 57 places in the UK rankings to 77th" out of over 6000 secondary schools.
