Meducators UK Medical Workshop

Dear Parent/Carer,

If your child is interested in a career in Medical Science they may wish to take part in the <u>Meducators Workshop being held in school on Wednesday 20 March 2024 between 9am and 12.20pm.</u>

The workshop will take place in school where there will be a Medicine and a Dentistry workshop running alongside each other. During the workshop, students will rotate around multiple stations, each of which will teach a different skill and provide them with a taster of what life is like in the healthcare profession. This is an interactive workshop so students are encouraged to participate with the clinical skills and answer questions alongside filling in work booklets which will be provided prior to the commencement of the session.

Each station is facilitated by a member of the healthcare profession, be it a doctor, dentist or medical student, and as such have been through the application process for University. There is a very competitive nature of the application process for these careers and the workshops hope to provide all students with an extra-curricular opportunity to aid their decision of pursuing careers in the healthcare field.

Participating students will receive a certificate of attendance following the workshop which can be used as a supporting document for their UCAS personal statements, CVs, portfolios or job applications in the future

The school is subsidising this workshop at £15 per student, however under the School Governors' Charging and Remissions Policy, we request a contribution of £17.50 towards the cost of this workshop. This includes the admission, and insurance. We must mention that without sufficient funding the workshop will be unable to take place. Please note that places are limited 100.
