Dear Parent/Carer

The Leeds Playhouse Macbeth Trip- Tuesday 19th March 2024

We have arranged for our Year 10 students to have the opportunity to travel to The Leeds Playhouse to watch a production of Shakespeare's Macbeth performed; this is part of their English Literature Paper 1 exam. Although we study the text in class; it is a play and therefore any opportunity to see it performed in its original form will support their understanding, so this trip will be an invaluable experience.

The visit is on 19/03/2024. We will travel by hired coach to Leeds, leaving school at approximately 09.30. We shall be setting off back from The Leeds Playhouse at approximately 14.30 and therefore expect to return to school at approximately 15.00 TBC, dependent on traffic.

Students should bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water- and any routine medication, which they usually carry, for example inhalers. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals a packed lunch can be provided please email <u>finance@heckgrammar.co.uk</u> for further details.

May I take this opportunity to remind parents that students are expected to be in their school uniform and to display the very highest standards of behaviour and courtesy. Please also be aware that due to safeguarding policies too, all students will be all taken from the HGS site to the venue and, brought back from the venue to the HGS site on allocated coaches. Please do not drop your child off The Leeds Playhouse pick them up or give permission to make their own way home from there. <u>If these conditions</u> <u>cannot be adhered to, please do not send your child on the trip.</u>

Under the School Governors' Charging and Remissions Policy, we request a contribution of <u>£24.50</u> towards the cost of this activity. This includes the admission, travel and insurance. We must mention that without sufficient funding, the trip will be unable to take place.
