## Arrangements for Year 7 Science trip to Magna Science Adventure Centre, Rotherham

Year 7 students will be travelling to Magna Science Adventure Centre to enhance the learning of our science curriculum and give pupils a chance to explore and discover science in a hands-on environment.

The visit is on Wednesday 5th June 2024. We will travel by hired coach to Magna in Rotherham leaving school at approximately 8.30 am. Students will need to be in school for 8 am to enable a prompt departure.

We will be setting off back from Magna at approximately 3.00pm and therefore expect to return to school at approximately 4pm TBC, dependent on traffic. Please arrange to collect your child from 4 pm or make arrangements for your child to get public transport home in the usual way at this time. Please can we ask parents to not park on North Street or Church Street before or after school to allow the coaches to park up.

Students will need to come dressed in non-uniform clothes e.g. leggings or tracksuit bottoms, a light T-shirt and a jacket. There is a water playground aspect of the trip so the clothes students wear should be clothes they don't mind getting wet. Students will need to bring a change of clothes in a separate plastic bag (that fits in their main bag) for the coach ride home.

Students can bring their mobile phones if needed for transport home, but will be asked to put them away whilst at magna to fully appreciate the experience. Any student using their phone inappropriately will have it confiscated in line with normal school policy.

Students should bring the following with them in a small bag/back pack:

- a packed lunch (any students who are eligible for free school meals and have requested a lunch for the trip will receive this on the morning of the trip).
- a bottle of water.
- any routine medication which they usually carry, for example inhaler, these must be labelled with the student's name.
- a change of clothes to come home in and a plastic bag (to put wet clothes in) inside their main bag.
- A small amount of money for the gift shop.
- Mobile phone if needed for transport home.

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May I take this opportunity to remind parents that students are expected to display the very highest standards of behaviour and courtesy.
