After Every Lesson

- 1 Read through notes from previous lesson, to consolidate your knowledge. Complete any independent learning questions at the back of your packs
- 2 Create revision resources such as revision cards, mind maps, record yourself
- 3 Highlight any areas that you have not understood – use resources to find out what you need to know
- 4 Ask questions (peers or your teacher) and contribute to the discussions

Weekly

- Complete one hour of Seneca to match the topics you are studying or about to study in lessons

- Practice all diagrams/theories learnt this term

Half Termly

- Re-review your notes from the last half term
- Highlight anything that you do not fully understand and bring questions to your lessons
- Organise your folder according to the Curriculum Intent document on Teams

Termly

- Re-visit areas of knowledge you did not understand previously.
- Use the revision resources you have created
- Complete past papers questions and use the mark scheme to self-assess your work this will give you the necessary practise of exam skills
