## After Every Lesson

- 1 Bring your AO4 booklet, your period 5 booklet and your exercise book.
- 2 Make sure all homework is fully completed to a high standard.
- 3 Speak French as much as possible.
- 4 Be pro-active in seeking support on any lesson content or skill that you need further clarification on

## Weekly

- Complete your period 5 private study task for that week .
- Complete all your homework.
- From the end of Year 12, complete your research for your IRP.
- Revise previously learnt grammar and vocabulary.
- Learn new vocabulary in Mot-à-Mot.
- Complete past paper questions.

## Fortnightly

Conduct super-curricular reading around the subject, to broaden your understanding of French-speaking culture and to develop your comprehension.  
Listen to as much authentic French as possible.

## Half-Termly

- Watch documentaries, series or films in the target language.
- Revise your AO4 from previous topics.
- Consolidate your content knowledge for your stepping stone.
- Make a priority list of areas where misconceptions are occurring
