<u>Task</u>

Read the below scenario

The year is 2040. There have been riots in the streets of London after Britain has run out of petrol because of an oil crises in the Middle East. Protestors have attacked public buildings. Several police officers have died.

Consequently, the government has deployed the army to curb the protests. After two days the protests have stopped but 25 people have been killed by the army.



<u>You are the Prime Minister. Write the script for a speech</u> to be broadcast to the nation in which you explain why employing the

army against violent protesters was the only option available to you and one which was both necessary and moral.



<u>Guidance</u>

The speech should be at least ¾'s of an A4 page if it is handwritten, if typed it should be a similar length. It is worth doing some research before you write your speech, for example, you could look at what previous Prime Ministers have said after riots. It is a good idea to make reference to any articles that you have found. Below is the marking criteria. You will not have to read these out.
