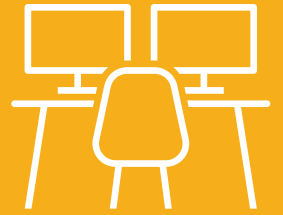


# What does Independent Learning in Spanish

## After Every Lesson

- 1 Bring your AO4 booklet, your period 5 booklet and your exercise book.
- 2 Make sure all homework is fully completed to a high standard.
- 3 Speak Spanish as much as possible.
- 4 Be pro-active in seeking support on any lesson content or skill that you need further clarification on

## Weekly

- Complete your period 5 private study task for that week in your period 5 booklet.
- Complete all directed study as set on ClassCharts.
- From the end of Year 12, complete your research for your Individual Research Project (IRP).
- Revise previously learnt grammar and vocabulary.
- Learn new vocabulary in Palabra Por Palabra.
- Complete past paper questions.

## Fortnightly

- Conduct super-curricular reading around the subject (see listed resources) to broaden your understanding of Hispanic culture and to develop your comprehension.
- Listen to as much authentic Spanish as possible (see listed resources below).

## Half-Termly

- Watch documentaries, series, podcasts or films in the target language. You could use Netflix, Amazon Prime, RTVE and/or Spotify.
- Revise your AO4 from previous topics.
- Consolidate your content knowledge for your stepping stone.
- Make a priority list of areas where misconceptions are occurring. Address these in your revision.
