Dear Parent/Carer

Year 12 University Open Day Trip to Bradford University - Monday 7 July

We have arranged for our Year 12 students to have the opportunity to travel to Bradford University to attend an on campus visit. There are a number of sessions that students will attend including university life and top tips, taster lectures and tours of key parts of the university. The aim is to help your child develop an understanding of university life and to support them in deciding if this is the route they would like to follow.

The visit is on Monday 7 July. We will travel by hired coach to Bradford University, leaving school at approximately 9.00am. We shall be setting off back from Bradford University at approximately 2.00pm and therefore expect to return to school at approximately 3.15pm, dependent on traffic.

We will expect all students to be at school by 8.45am. Students will be given the opportunity to explore Bradford University without a teacher being present (as they will each want to see different things on the day). Students will be expected to stay in groups of a minimum of three. All students will be expected to return to school using the coach provided and be at the coach for 1.45pm. May I take this opportunity to remind parents that students are expected to display the very highest standards of behaviour and courtesy.

Students should bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water – along with any routine medication which they usually carry, for example inhalers. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals a packed lunch can be provided please email finance@heckgrammar.co.uk for further details.
