Arrangements for Collecting A-Level Results

GCE A level results will be published on Thursday 14 August 2025 and will be available from school between 8.00am and 10.00am. Students and accompanying parents should enter the school through the main reception and make their way to the Sports Hall to collect their results. In the event that the new building is not yet open, please use the Sports Hall entrance instead. Signage will be in place to guide you on the day.

This is usually a fantastic event, and we look forward to welcoming you back into school. There will also be the opportunity to have your photograph taken by yourself, with your friends and/or family and teachers/senior leaders who will be available throughout the morning.

If you are unable to attend results day, we can email you your results at 8.00am. Please email <u>exams@heckgrammar.co.uk</u> should you require this. We can only email results to your school email address. Results cannot be collected by anybody else without prior permission.

Any results that have not been collected or emailed as described above, will be emailed to students at 11.00am.

When you are issued your results, either in person or via email, you will also receive a destination form. Please complete this and hand it in to a member of the Sixth Form team before you leave or email it to <u>exams@heckgrammar.co.uk</u> if you have received your results via email. We will also ask for contact details so that we can inform you of future events such as the Prize Giving evening in December.

<u>Re-marks</u>

Each year several students request for their papers to be remarked because they have scored close to a grade boundary. We highly recommend that you do this as grades do often improve. This year, to support this process if a student is within 2 UMS MARKS of an overall grade boundary the school will pay the re-marking of one paper in that subject. If this applies to any of your subjects, please visit the "Re-marks" desk that will be set up in the Sports Hall to discuss your options.

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If you are within 3 or 4 marks of a grade boundary, please talk to a member of staff about entering your paper(s) for a remark as this may well be worth it.

Requesting Scripts

Each year our teaching staff use students' scripts to understand how the exam boards have assessed various aspects of the curriculum. This is incredibly useful professional development for teaching and learning purposes and was also beneficial to you as a student because we have used this information throughout your time with us. To request a script from an exam board we require permission from students, so we will be asking all students to sign a consent form upon collection of their results to allow us to do this. We will not request every student's script, just a selection and where we do request a script a student copy will be made available upon request. If a student does not want to give us consent to do this, that is fine, however it is especially useful if we can.

Further Support

If you need any further support with your university application, the Sixth Form Team and the Careers Team will be available in school to help you through any processes such as UCAS and Clearing. They will be based in the SCR.

If you require any further help after your results such as appeals, and other re-marks then please see the <u>Post Results</u> section of the school website for full details – this will be updated during the summer when we have all the details from the exam boards.
