Medical Mavericks Mini-medics workshop on Wednesday 15 April 2026

Your child has expressed an interest in taking part in the Medical Mavericks Mini-medics workshop on Wednesday 15 April 2026.

The event will take place **in school** over a 2-hour period, the session is designed to give students an insight into medical careers as well as medicine. Activities include measuring blood vessel diameter and circumferences with an ultrasound, lung volumes, respiration rates, iPhone retina scan, try keyhole surgery, taking fake blood and recording an ECG.

The aim of the workshop is to explore a range of medical careers but also allow students to gain some hands-on experience. The company have appeared on shows such as the one show and the big bang fair and they are renowned for being inspiring in their delivery of events.
